

# ResponseCard LT<sup>®</sup>

The ResponseCard LT is an audience response device used when a presenter wants to gather immediate feedback from the audience.



## CHANGING THE CHANNEL

1. Press the **Channel** button.
2. Enter the **two-digit** channel number. i.e. 11 or 52

**NOTE:** Channel numbers can only contain numbers 1 - 5.

3. Press the **Channel** button.  
A **green** flash indicates the channel was successfully changed.

## RESPONDING

- A **green** flash indicates that the response was received.
- Two **red** flashes indicate that the answer choice was invalid.
- A single **yellow** flash indicates that polling is closed.
- Multiple **yellow** flashes indicate that the response is sending.
- Multiple **yellow** flashes followed by a **red** flash indicate that the response was not received.
